## Safety Data Sheet (SDS) Request Instructions

## Requesting New Manual:

Utilize our "Safety Data Sheet (SDS) Chemical Inventory & Updates" form to list all chemical products that present a physical or health hazard.

\*\* We do not accept ordering lists as they contain many non-hazardous products and duplicate materials.

Examples of non-hazardous products:

- "Articles" (gloves, masks, syringes, etc).
- FDA drugs in solid final form for direct administration.
- Consumer products used as intended at a frequency/duration of a "typical consumer".

\* If you are unsure if a product is hazardous write it down and we will determine that for you.

Helpful suggestions:

- Write the <u>full</u> name of the product to ensure we have the correct product (i.e. "Filtek Supreme Ultra Universal Restorative" or "Filtek Supreme Flowable Restorative" vs "Filtek").
- <u>Include</u> percentages and/or the form of the product (i.e. liquid, powder, spray, gel, etc).
- Varying shades and flavors <u>do not</u> need to be listed.
- Remember to include your fire extinguishers, oxygen, and nitrous (if applicable).

## Requesting Updates:

- 1. From a copy of the SDS Index, draw a single line through products no longer in use or "inactive".
- 2. List all new products on the SDS Chemical Inventory & Updates form.
